





HONORARY CONSUL GENERAL OF THE REPUBLIC OF PALAU TO INDIA



PRESIDENT: HONY. CONSULAR CORPS DIPLOMATIQUE - INDIA

Mr. K.L. Ganju a businessman by profession became the Consul General (Hy.) of the Union of Comoros in the year 2005. The gazette th notification for his appointment was issued by Govt. of India on 10 January, 2005. Mr. Ganju at the initial stage of his life had to abandon his education to standby his father at the time of crises in the family. But he was determined to make a mark in his life. At the age of 19 years he stated a small business which grew steadily. He continued his struggle and achieved his desired goals. He married Dr. Gurdeep Kaur and started living happily. He has two daughters. After giving good education to them, he got them married. Right from the beginning of his life he was devoted towards helping the under-privileged, he continued to give education to the poor children and helping getting married the daughters of the poor families. Apart from this, he was instrumental in collecting funds for the Indian Spinal Injury Center which is today one of the best Spinal Injuries Hospital in India. For this effort, he collaborated with Maj. H.P.S. Ahluwalia (the Everest Hero). But the zeal to do something special continued. In the year 2004 he was offered to become the Consul General (Hy.) of the Union of Comoros in India. Initially he declined this offer, but ultimately due to some good friends he agreed to take the responsibility. After assuming the charge of the Consul General (Hy.) he realized that this is the best way to help the needy people wherever they are and also promote good bilateral relations between India and Union of Comoros. He established Embassy like Hony. Consulate in

New Delhi and started working. He realized that there is no traffic of people from Union of Comoros to India either for education, medical treatment or business. He used his skill to convince the people and Govt, of the Union of Comoros to send their patients for medical treatment to India which has good medical facilities available at a reasonable prize. He also convinced the students of Union of Comoros to come to India for education. Though Union of Comoros is a francophone country still students came to India, learnt English and thereafter completed their graduation, post-graduation and also some of them did doctorate. The biggest satisfaction which came to Mr. Ganju was when serious patients started coming to India for treatment. During the course of their treatment it gave Mr. Ganju opportunity to serve them, help them at the time of need. This also includes, sometimes, giving family blood to the patients at the time of operation. This action of Mr. Ganju became talk of the town in the diplomatic community in Delhi and people in Comoros. This service of Mr. Ganju continued and is still on. Having achieved to serve the people of Comoros, Mr. Ganju also played an important role in promoting bilateral relations between India and Union of Comoros. Today the bilateral relations between the two countries are its best. Mr. Ganju is proud of his achievements and in the process he published a book titled "The Golden Decade 2005-15, My life as Hony. Consul General". During the printing of the book, the comments Mr. Ganju received from dignitaries including Hon'ble President of the Union of Comoros are remarkable and satisfying. Some of the comments are mentioned below: Hon'ble President of the Union of Comoros wrote I quote "So I am glad to say that during this decade, thanks to the tireless efforts of Mr. Ganju, there has been much improvement in Indo-Comorian relations, whether in terms of high level visits, economic interaction or people to people contact." - 1. Gusi Peace Prize, citation of which is signed by the Hon'ble President of Philippines. He is the 7 Indian to receive this award.
- 2. Pride of India leadership award from Kent, United Kingdom.
- 3. "Gold Medal" by Amity International University, Noida.

Apart from the above he has received many other National and International Awards.



Known as a Fierce lady lawyer who is a doctorate in Constitutional law and Human Rights and a hardcore social advocate of women's rights in India. Dr Kshitija Wadatkar moves in and out of Top corporate circles in India – as the founder and lead partner of M/s Kshitija Wadatkar & Associates, she has handled several high-profile cases, such as representing Zerodha COO in the #metoo movement, Shilpa Shetty defamation case and so on. She represents topmost companies like Shapoorji Palonji, Lodha and Adani's. But not many know the remarkable journey of a girl who started out with just her exceptional brain and no privileges and achieved what she did with grit, intelligence and hard work

This small-town girl came 14 years back in the time with one briefcase in Mumbai to Practice at the Principal Bench of the Bombay High Court. As she had no reference she needed to work under the criminal lawyer of the Bombay High Court who selected her on basis of her gold medals and merits. She started her journey with a 5000 rs stipend. Shortly a bright lady lawyer got selected for a top-tier law firm whereby she got extensive experience working for eminent corporate houses in the country. She learned the nuances of corporate laws. In 2015 she took a risk of starting her law firm with her entrepreneurial spirit and since then she never looked back.

Her journey as a lawyer has been an inspiring one, and she has grown in the strict environment of her professor's parents who always impacted her mindset for principles of integrity in professional life. Her learnings gathered over the years and her outstanding academics, she says. Advising a client through a crisis or a high-stake contentious matter sharpened her instincts and ability to strategise, and advising on transactions tested her skills to negotiate and arrive at a consensus. She also learnt to be patient yet firm, tactful yet commercially adept. "Whether you're in a courtroom or corporate room, two big learnings would be that a successful output can never be found based on 'my way or the highway and that there's rarely ever a slam-dunk.

I never underestimate that someone's reputation and life are in my hands, and I must do my best to safeguard it," she explains. She plays a pivotal role in strategising complicated legal matters and getting them settled. Her leadership champions the disposal rate with positive outcomes. The very result is she grabbed top corporate houses. Presently she is representing top corporate houses of the country in their corporate matters at NCLT, High Court, and almost all courts of Maharashtra. She has her brand name in economic offence cases, and criminal and corporate matters. Currently, she is a standing counsel for the UNION OF INDIA representing cases for banking frauds, anti-corruption, and Economic Offences for CBI and E.D with her strong understanding of money laundering, the passport act, and criminal procedure.

Dr Kshitija is passionate about gender issues and women's rights in India. As a part of her legal awareness for women she frequently gets invited to leading institutions of the country for expert lectures on women's laws and woman empowerment. She is an acclaimed speaker and hence got invited to National level Law Festivals as a Chief Guest.

She is a member of the International Law Firm (Global Business Lawyers League) which works globally in commercial legal issues. "I observe and learn from other great judges and lawyers and the things they do differently during their work and draw great influence from it. I think the key is to never really stop learning," she says. PhD in constitutional law and human rights, Her future goals include writing a book on women's laws and making legal education more accessible to anyone and everyone who needs to apply it in their professional lives. She offers pro bono legal services to distressed women. A poet by heart Dr Kshitija is a popular sociopolitical writer whose articles frequently get published in the leading newspaper of the country. During the pandemic whoever criticised the MVA government in Maharashtra, the jail become the norm, in those times to increase the awareness of the law on arrest for Suo

moto advocates team of Maharashtra, she conducted various seminars/webinars and workshops to increase the morale of the advocates who pursue rights of arrested individuals.

## RANNI KAMAL



The Juvenile Justice (Care and Protection of Children) Act 2015, which is an act to consolidate and amend the law relating to children alleged to be in conflict with the law and children in need of care and protection, by adopting a child-friendly approach in the adjudication, she educates minors and also provides vocational training to them in juvenile homes and makes them job- ready, through which they will be least involved in illegal activities and will be able to work skilfully, and they can also help their families through financial support. The organisation has constructed more than 1200 shelter homes for migrant workers with the help of Nagpur Municipal Cooperation. These migrant workers were being taught basic household activities like stitching paper bags, doormats, and handloom activities so that they would not be a liability to anyone and be independent and earn for themselves and their families.



It immediately struck me, what about radiology services in these hospitals With a bit of research I realized how difficult it is for the under privileged people who visit these hospitals to avail services since they do not provide quality diagnostic services at a general hospital and have to get referred to district

hospitals where there is a coupon system for radiological services that keeps them waiting for months.

I then decided to take up the job as a Consultant Radiologist under the National Rural health mission (NRHM) and worked in Jayanagar General Hospital (2018 and 2019)

There is an immense satisfaction in providing service to the people who actually need it but cannot afford to receive it. There is real scarcity of Specialists especially in Radiodiagnosis in these hospitals and there is a huge demand. This experience then led me to believe I can do more to help underprivileged people

Following the ancient saying of Never Stop Learning, I update myself through regular POSH Trainings for all, Certification on Agile HR Methodologies and Labour Laws.



# **PORTIA PUTATUNDA**



Planet Spiti Foundation was started by Portia Putatunda, a former Media Professional with over 10 years of work experience with top News Powerhouses in the country. She quit her job with the CNN-News18 in 2019 and started her social work journey. She was always a wanderer at heart with a heart to give back to the society. So, she would often carry books and stationery for children on her solo trips to offbeat locations in Sikkim, North Bengal, Rajasthan, Uttarakhand, Himachal Pradesh, and Punjab. Soon she begun to realise her true calling is in educating and transforming the future of this highaltitude desert region surrounded by the Himalayas on all sides called the Spiti Valley. Post the pandemic, she was in the valley and started to run a small library and a primary learning centre. Before she knew what lies ahead, Planet Spiti Foundation was already born. Under this foundation, Planet Spiti Foundation has identified rural school girls and boys in 75 different villages of Spiti and over 150 villages in Lahaul with low female participation in education. PSF's single-minded focus is on providing quality primary education to rural children who have no access to school education, hygiene, health care because of lack of schools, or funds, or motivation. Planet Spiti has identified problems plaguing young children's

primary education in Lahaul and Spiti district of Himachal Pradesh and has developed a fun learning model that overcomes these problems viz. the Planet Spiti Residential School model.

Under this model in early 2021, PSF established connection with the rural children and their parents, deliver books at their homes, conducts Spoken English, English reading, singing, reciting, art, and English writing workshops in rural villages, tutor children from classes UKG – 6 at the single-teacher Primary Learning Center in Kaza with high concentration of children in the 2-13 year age group.

These young children started to reap benefits from the learning center approach as it is near to their homes. Thus, Planet Spiti takes the school to their door steps. The Foundation conducted several educational workshops based on History, Literature, Music, Dance, Sports, Society, and Drama on a regular basis through play-way methods. The Learning Center is also house to the PlanetSpiti Library that makes fun learning through books, maps, pictures, dictionary, documentaries, films a part of another fun-learning everyday.

In April 2022, Planet Spiti Foundation opened its gate to the first batch of free residential set up of Planet Spiti Residential School with three underprivileged children living with Portia in Kaza. It was started with an aim to reform the educational system of Spiti Valley. PSRS Alternative School has now expanded to a bigger eco-friendly campus in the World's Highest Motorable Village of Komic to run its classes and house students from Nursery to Class III by early 2023.

In no way is Planet Spiti a conventional learning space but a safe haven to pursue social, practical, traditional, environmental knowledge, life skills, and values. The campus aims to become fully solar-heated and solar-powered where students can learn ancient Spiti history, music, dance, along with modern academic knowledge. Our aim is to build leaders and that is why the older students will engage in managing, running, teaching, and maintaining the school campus.

Spiti Valley is a high-altitude desert region surrounded by the Himalayas on all sides with a rich history and culture influenced by Tibet, China, Ladakh, and Central Asia. The Valley was closed to the outside world since 1959 to the early 90s. Recent decades have witnessed much national and international tourists and some development. Planet Spiti Foundation strives to build young Spitians and other locals, particularly those from an underprivileged background, with the skills, practical knowledge, perspective, and a boost in their confidence to create a sustainable future in the valley.

Born in a Banker Family, I had no plans to get associated with Banks. My hobby was Paintings and I loved doing it and was passionate about it.

I am a very adventurous person and would like to take the risk\_careful risks. I like to do creative thing besides doing old stuff again and again. Learning new things is one thing which I have always enjoyed. Stay updated myself with the news. I am fond of reading books which helps me to learn high morals and values.

I completed my Graduation and settled down in Vadodara, Gujarat.

Turning Point:

My Journey as an Entrepreneur was way back in Year 2014. Named after my two daughters...Aashna & Dweeja – myself and my husband established Aadwee Asset Resolution Company. The initial assignment that I started was tough – seizing of tractors and that too in the far off villages in Bardoli, Surat, Gujarat. Being the first assignment, we had to cut on our expenses and therefore I used to travel by the local transportations. I took up the challenge and seized 9 tractors in a day – this first assignment gave me the confidence, and then there was no looking back...

Addwee - having built the confidence we convinced the Banks / Financial Institutions to become Resolution and Enforcement Agents under SARFAESI Act, which covers recovery of pending dues of Secured Creditors under Immovable Assets i.e. House, Shops/Office and Factory premises - all taken up under legal way.

About Aadwee Asset Resolution Company - AARC

Aadwee Asset Resolution Company (AARC) got established in the Year 2014 to carry out activities under the field of Recovery of Non Performing Assets (NPA). NPA is nothing but the loans that are being given by Banks / Financial Institutions whose Principal as well as the interest amounts have been in a state of overdue status for a fairly long time. When we say "fairly long time", it is 90 days or more than 90 days. Similar to any other business, the banks also should be profitable, but NPA eats up a large portion of the banks' margin. Thus;

- · NPA reduces the Profits of Banks/FI
- · It reduces its Capital Adequacy
- · Banks have become averse to giving loans and taking risks

#### Factors that Contribute to NPA

The factors that contribute to Non-Performing Assets (NPA) are as follows:

- . The bank's lending to the corporations/persons etc. whose creditworthiness is not guaranteed and taking a lot of high risks.
- The banks are not able to diminish their losses by a complete understanding of the sufficiency of the bank in terms of the loan
  or capital loss at a specific time frame.
- The funds are being redirected elsewhere by the promoters of the companies.
- · The banks that try to fund projects that are not viable.
- · Not enough means to collect as well as distribute credit information in between the commercial banks and
- · Non-efficient recovery of the debts from the overdue borrowers.

#### Aadwee's Role in reduction of NPAs:

We are now on panel with 18 Banks/FI providing services within Gujarat.

- · We render services to Banks/Financial Institutions, for assisting them in recovery of their outstanding dues.
- · We assist them in taking possession, extending custodial services, marketing and selling of the seized asset.
- · Due diligence and legal vetting of the documents.
- Assisting / liaising with concerned District Magistrate (DM) and Chief Metropolitan Magistrate (CMM) for getting orders for seizure of assets.
- Recovery of dues from the borrowers by way of persuasion, OTS, compromise, sale (including e-auction) or realizing the dues by any means.

Since then it has been a Memorable Journey (...and the Journey is still going on) as the work I carry covers a lot of risk and is less preferred among women – all chances are that I might be the only women who is handling Resolutions of Non-Performing Assets (NPA) within Banks.

I am a postgraduate in Bharatanatyam and Choreography from Nalanda Nritya Kala Mahavidyalaya, University of Mumbai. Presently pursuing PhD in inter-disciplinary subjects of Dance and Drama from Dept of Performing Arts, Dr Babasaheb Ambedkar Marathwada University, Aurangabad. I am also Asst. Professor at the dept of Dramatics and Dance here in the university.

It was a childhood journey as I belong to family of performing artistes in Hyderabad where three of my paternal aunts are eminent personalities in the field of classical dances namely Kuchipudi and Bharatanatyam. Thus, the seed of the dance was sown in me since I was a toddler and went on to enrol myself in a degree course in dance at Nalanda Nritya Kala Mahavidyalaya affiliated to University of Mumbai at the insistence of my aunt and Guru Dr Rajyalakshmi Seth from Mumbai. Thus began my dance journey and studying at Nalanda Nritya Kala Mahavidyalaya introduced me to a world of our vast culture and heritage.

Staying in a big city like Mumbai opened many opportunities as well as collaborations, interactions and thus I met my husband Ramdas Pawar who is an educationist, poet, writer and artist. Our teaching jobs took us to the hills of Mussoorie and Rishikesh in Uttarakhand to Kanpur in Uttar Pradesh, allowing me to spread my dance wings. Got many opportunities as choreographer, teacher and dance therapist in boarding schools, Ashrams and colleges. With the vast multi-cultural exposure and experience behind me, I settled in Aurangabad in the year 2006 and then began my journey of self-exploration and aim of life.

With so much travel and seeing different cultures and best of the amenities in educational and cultural institutions in metro cities, my dream was to create a space where I settle – a modern Gurukul, so thus the idea of Devmudraa came and it became a reality from our drawing room to school halls to our own space now where we have a performance hall, rehearsal rooms, audio –video equipped

Our institute Devinudraa a movement school is run by Devmudraa Trust in Aurangabad established in the year 2007. It is dedicated to the spread of performing arts, especially classical dance and allied art forms through quality educational courses affiliated to reputed universities in the country and also give exposure to our students from Aurangabad and Marathwada region to the experts and eminent artistes from all over the country and abroad through lecture-demonstrations, workshops and festivals in Aurangabad.

We have students from the small town and rural districts of Marathwada region. In the last fifteen years we have made a name for ourselves in the field of classical dance and performing arts thus giving diploma to post graduate level training in Bharatanatyam and Kuchipudi dance forms, short term course in Dance teacher training, choreography, folk dances, drama and music. Our students are excelling in exams and state and national level competitions and also received CCRT Merit scholarships. We have a professional performing troupe as well as children group attending and performing at various festivals in India and abroad.

Though we had teething problems and had face many obstacles for quite some number of years, as still people are not aware about the seriousness of dance as a profession and they are not exposed to the amount of good and scholarly work being done in the field of dance and art across the country and abroad. But slowly with times and media and internet, things are changing for the better and we are happy atleast we are contributing little to the growth and promotion of our culture and classical dance forms in this area, even if it is amountable to a drop in the big ocean, but making a difference.

My journey and the realisation that Art whether it is dance, music or drama is the strongest communicator prompted us to encourage more and more children and students to take careers in alternative subjects apart from the regular career options. A student with a creative bent of mind can go for such courses but the fear of lack of employment in these fields is stopping the parents to enrol their children in such courses, but getting a university degree or diploma and creating new jobs in this field is our motto. So t is more than a business for us. It is our mission to give quality education in performing arts to the students of this Marathwada reWe give opportunity to each and every student, create a platform for them so that they gain confidence and our students are sent for participation in competitions and also in festivals across the country and abroad too.

We have been already implementing many innovative methods and tools using technology in our institute for the last eight year much before the pandemic happened and the online mode of teaching took a front seat and many technologies and apps developed in the last three years. We have audio-visual room and library, also our students are trained in editing of sound and video apart from the performing aspects. 


have to focus more on Mother Nature.
